FURTHER REGULATIONS

FOR V8 SUPERCARS

1. Clothing Requirement

Each Driver must wear a patch as provided by the Promoters, on each Driver's racing suit, located either on the upper chest or the front of one arm, which must be clearly visible at all times while the Driver is wearing the racing suit which must be worn at any promotional appearances as required pursuant to the Supplementary Regulations.
