1130 Cars in position on the grid.
1150 Drivers in cars ready.
1200 Parade start. - Team Mechanics to follow by mini bus.
1205 V8 Supercars park up in front of Town Hall.
1215 Reception for Drivers at Town Hall.

1240 Team Mechanics drive V8 Supercars back to Pit Lane.

Drivers: All V8 Supercar Drivers

Cars:

All V8 Supercars competing in Round 1 of the VCS

Uniform: All Drivers must be in dress Team Uniform.

Tyres:

Teams will be required to use wet tyres for this parade.

Course: Attached is a map showing the course the cars will follow for the parade.

The streets being used will be closed to all other traffic while the parade is taking place. The Cars will start on the Clipsal 500 grid and make their way to the Adelaide Town Hall. Here the cars will be parked in a fenced off area manned by security. The return trip will require a mechanic from each team to drive the cars back down Wakefield St and into the Pit Lane in the reverse direction. The cars will be traveling between 60 and 80 km/h along both routes with the total distance of the return trip is approximately 4.7km.
